- The competition is open to high school students only.
- Participants may compete individually or in teams up to 4 students.
- Each student entry must be original in concept and design.

REGISTRATION AND SUBMISSION INFORMATION

- During the Competition Submission Period, create an account on www.challengepost.com and register for the House App Contest.
- Upload your entry form on this website so Congressman Kline can communicate with you during the Competition Submission Period.
- Submission Requirements:
 - Each entry must be submitted through the challengepost.com website.
 - A link must be sent with an Application Demonstration Video. (ChallengePost supports Youtube and VIMEO).
 - A link to the Developer video. The participant will explain how they created the app, and what they have learned.
 - A completed entry form.

IMPORTANT DATES

- Saturday, February 1: Competition Submission Period opens.
- Sunday, March 30: Competition Submission Period closes at 11:59 p.m. All entries must be submitted through the Challengepost.com website.
- Mid-April: Judging Session for all of the entries.
- Early May: Winners are announced.
- Mid-May: Winner's app is posted on the House.gov website.
